Specifications

The five themes are:

- 1. Identity and culture
- 2. Local area, holiday, travel
- 3. School
- 4. Future aspirations, study and work
- 5. International and global dimension.

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1. Identity and culture

• Who am I?:

relationships; when I was younger; what a good friend; interests; socialising with friends and family; role models

Daily life:

customs and everyday life; food and drink; shopping; social media and technology (use of, advantages and disadvantages)

Cultural life:

celebrations and festivals; reading; music; sport; film and television

2. Local area, holiday and travel

- Holidays:
 preferences; experiences; destinations
- Travel and tourist transactions:
 travel and accommodation; asking for help
 and dealing with problems; directions;
 eating out; shopping
- Town, region and country weather; places to see; things to do

3. School

• What school is like:

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school types; school day; subjects; rules and pressures; celebrating success
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School activities:

school trips; events and exchanges

4. Future aspirations, study and work

- Using languages beyond the classroom: forming relationships; travel; employment
- Ambitions:
 further study; volunteering; training
- Work: jobs; careers and professions

5. International and global dimension

Bringing the world together:
 sports events; music events; campaigns
 and
 good causes

Environmental issues:
 being 'green'; access to natural resources

Overview of specification

- Listening -
 - choice of Mandarin or Cantonese
 - multiple-choice & open-ended short answers
 - Q & A in English
- Speaking
 - Choice of Mandarin or Cantonese
 - Preparation time = 12 min, Test time = 10-12 min
 - 3 tasks : Role play, Picture-based task, conversation
- Reading
 - Reading comprehension on 9 authentic literary texts

- Writing
 - 1 informal writing (80 110 characters)
 - 1 formal writing (130-180 characters)
 - 1 translation from English to Chinese (about 50 words)

New GCSE Features

- Choice of Mandarin or Cantonese, traditional or simplified characters
- Topics encourage learning of Chinese Culture
- All papers externally set and marked
- Equal weighing for 4 papers, 25% each
- Instructions, questions and answers in English
- Graded questions to encourage progression
- Short translations from & into Chinese
- Reading passages from authentic literary texts
- Speaking focus on interaction & spontaneity
- Writing given choice of questions
- First exam in June 2019

International GCSE

Specification

- Paper 1 Listening 25%
- Paper 2 -Reading & writing 50%
- Paper 3 Speaking 25%
- Papers externally set and marked
- Available in May / June

Common topic areas

- A Home and abroad
- B Education and employment
- C Personal life and relationships
- D The world around us
- E Social activities, fitness and health

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Sample themes:

- A Holidays, Travelling
 Everyday life, traditions and communities
- B School life and routine Future plans, Work/careers
- C Friends & Family relationships Food and drink, Home and domestic routine
- D Environmental issues, Technology,
 Travel and transport, The media, etc
- E Special occasions, Shopping, Health issues,
 - Hobbies, interests, sports and exercise

Features

- For listening and reading:
 - identify and note main points
 - deduce the meaning of words from context
 - extract specific details
 - identify points of view
 - show some understanding of unfamiliar language
 - recognise attitudes, emotions and opinions.
 - Passages in various forms: dialogues, statements, letters, interviews, prose etc.
- For writing
 - 1 translation from English to Chinese
 - 1 short piece of 60-75 characters on a given task
 - 1 writing of up to 150 characters on 1 of the 3 given topics

Speaking Assessment

- Section A Presentation and discussion based on a single picture
 - chosen by candidate
 - 1 min presentation followed by 3 min discussion
 - Total time: 3 min
- Section B 2 conversations
 - Based on 2 different topic areas
 - Topics chosen by teacher
 - Total time: 7 min

Paper 1: Listening, 40%

Reading

Translation into English

Paper 2: Written response to works 30%

Translation into Chinese

Paper 3: Speaking 30%

AS - Responses to Theme 1 & 2 topics

AL - Response to a topic in a sub-theme

Present & discuss on own research topic

Features

- Q & A mainly in Chinese
- Translation from & into Chinese (about 100 characters / words)
- Listening & reading focus on summarizing skills
- Writing focus on critical writing skills
- Speaking testing knowledge of culture and changes in China
- Research topic is assessed in AL speaking
- Written response to 1. literary text, 2. film with choice of questions on prescribed lists
- AS & AL Chinese are linear, stand-alone exam
- AS first exam June 2018, AL first exam June 2019.
