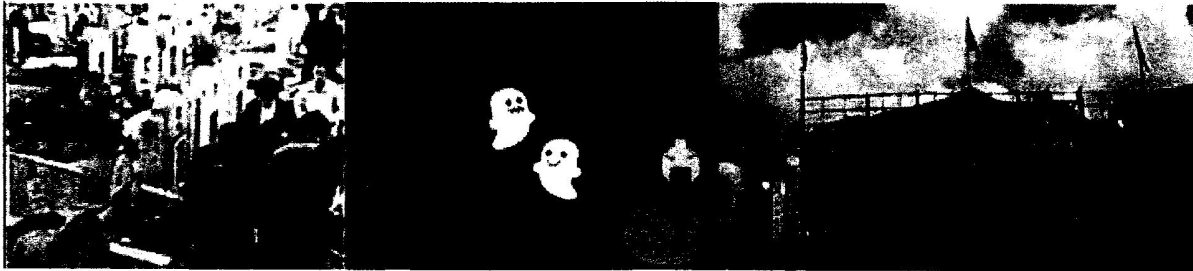

During the Qingming Festival the living descendants pay homage to their ancestors and during the Ghost Month the deceased visit the living. The seventh month in the lunar calendar is the Ghost Month, in which ghosts and spirits, including those of the deceased ancestors, come out from the lower realm. Though the Ghost Festival shares some similarities with the Halloween celebrated by the western countries, a very distinct difference is that we do not dress up in ghost costumes and parade from house to house to ask for treats.
