 - Listening 40 mins + 5 min reading time, Total 40 marks
 - Reading 50 mins, Total 40 marks
- Time-tabled exam in May/ June
- Externally marked by Examiners

The Controlled Assessments

Writing Controlled Assessment

- Choose a **Topic** from the **Themes**
- Decide on the Writing Task
- Sort out the Stimulus
- Up to 2 weeks preparation time & 6 hrs guidance from the teacher
- Make notes on the Notes Form (CA₄)
- Assign 1 hr supervised session for writing the Essay
- Fill in details & sign on the Mark sheet
- Send to the Examiner for marking

Speaking Controlled assessment

- Select 2 different topics from the Themes
- Select 2 different speaking tasks from

Open interaction

Picture-based discussion

Presentation & discussion

- Prepare notes on the Notes-form (CA2)
- Each assessment lasts 4-6 min
- Marked by the teacher
- Send to Examboard for moderation

- Section B 2 conversations
 - Based on 2 different topic areas
 - Topics chosen by teacher
 - Total time: 6 min; Total mark: 20

 - non verbal & answers in Chinese / English
- Section C Writing
 - 200 characters on a given topic

UNIT₃ (A₂)

- Section A Reading comprehension answers in Chinese
- Section B translation
 - English to Chinese
- Section C- Writing 1
 - 250 500 characters on a given topic
 - 250 500 characters on a Research-based topic
